interaction, a picture-based free-flowing discussion or a presentation with discussion following.
Unit 3 – 20%: Reading and Understanding 50 minutes
The examination consists of a number of short texts, notices or news reports in Italian which include
a range of settings and styles, both formal and informal (e.g. text messages, advertisements, emails).

Unit 4 – 30%: Writing – controlled assessment
You must complete two separate writing tasks and each of these must be undertaken in controlled
conditions in a single assessment session of no more than one hour. Minimum 200 words each.
